HOW CAN I ATTEND?

Classes run from the beginning of February to the end of November.

New intake is the first Saturday of each month. Handlers wishing to attend are asked to pre-book their class placements by phoning the numbers listed on this brochure.

For your first week with us:

We ask that you attend <u>WITHOUT YOUR DOG</u> and please bring with you:

- A Chair
- Your completed Application Form and Payment (Please note that we do not have credit card facilities available)
- Your dog's current vaccination certificate
- On Week 2:
- Please wear your name badge as issued in week 1
- Please ensure that your dog's collar is fitted properly (as shown in week 1)
- Please arrive 15-30 minutes early to sign in, enable your dog to settle down and so that your classes can start and finish on time.
- Don't forget to wear sensible clothing and footwear (no sandals or thongs).
- Please bring a chair and a drink for you and your dog training can be thirsty work.

Please Note: Not all dogs are suitable for group training. If you have a behaviour or agression issue with your dog please advise us so that an individual assessment can be arranged prior to joining.
