CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW - No. 2

JUDGE: Mrs Lorraine Tooth (UK)

Thank you to the Committee for inviting me to Judge this show and thank you to the exhibitors for entering and travelling so far. I found the standard in Australia to be very high, generally good mouths and heads, movement was very good and temperament found to be excellent. Handling of the dogs by their owners was also of a high standard, which made my job most enjoyable.

CLASS 1 : BABY PUPPY DOG (7 entries – 1 absent) The 'Baby Puppy' Dog Class was a joy to Judge – such well behaved babies and a bright future I'm sure for most.

- Gunnislake Grand Acclaim (Mrs E Gent) Best Baby Puppy
 Yellow baby with the most delightful head lovely balanced proportions, dark
 pigmentation, correct bite, good reach of neck, well angulated front and rear, moved
 true and straight, in good coat and tail.
- 2 Majoley Great Expectations (S Burnley)
 Darker yellow baby with a lovely head and expression, well defined stop, kind eyes, well balanced throughout. In good coat and tail, moved well.
- 3 Cladaghring Southern Cross (S & Mrs D O'Donnelly)
 Lovely puppy with a sweet head, good pigmentation, correct bite. Lovely clean angles front and rear. A little unsettled on the move.

CLASS 2: MINOR PUPPY DOG (4 entries – 2 absent)

1 Miandoe On A Whim (M & J Anderson)

Chocolate puppy with a lovely rich colour, correct pigmentation and eye colour. Good reach of neck, well angulated front with a firm top line and a good tail set. Strong rear quarters, moved and showed well.

2 Bonnsway Time Warp (Ms D Travers)

Yellow boy, attractive promising head, well balanced throughout. In good coat and a well covered tail, movement a little loose, hopefully this will improve.

CLASS 3: PUPPY DOG (5 entries)

1 Driftway Foreign Envoy (G Spagnolo)

Yellow puppy shown in super condition. Nicely proportioned head, with excellent pigmentation, used his ears to advantage. Good all round angles, firm top line, good barrel rib, moved with drive true and straight.

2 Blackrange Sourcerer's Apprentice (Catraz Kennels)

Classy black boy with a lovely front, firm top line and well muscled rear, although on the move he wasn't totally together (perhaps a little slower?) Lovely head and expression, in good coat, with a really good tail.

3 Rodorbal Magic To Do (S & R Malseed)

Lovely black dog with a good head and expression, a good kind eye, well balanced through body. In excellent coat, tail set a little low, when settled he moved well.

CLASS 4: JUNIOR DOG (5 entries)

1 Driftway Special Misssion (G Spagnolo)

Really lovely yellow boy, just right for his age. Excelled in front angulation, firm top line, barrel ribbed, well angulated rear, strong bone and super compact round feet. Pleasing head not over done in any way, with good pigmentation and correct bite. Moved true and straight with good extension.

2 Rifintime Special Maple (T & Mrs M Ament)

Very nice type of yellow with lovely head and good pigmentation. Well angulated front and rear in very good coat, moved well.

3 Aralyen Study In Time (Mrs A O'Connor)

A black boy with pleasing head and expression, deep bodied throughout, good spring of rib, flowing top line, moved well.

CLASS 5 : INTERMEDIATE DOG (8 entries – 1 absent)

1 Ch Cladaghring Flynn Over Torngat (AI) (S & Mrs D O'Donnell)

Classy black dog, plenty of substance overall. Broad well shaped skull, pleasing expression, good depth of body, with a good spring of rib, firm level top line, well angulated front and rear, moved soundly with a free flowing action.

2 Gunnislake Jackson Brown (Mrs E Gent)

Pleasing chocolate dog, with a lovely rich colour to his coat, correct pigmentation, delightful head with balanced proportions, well angulated throughout, good barrel ribbed, good depth of brisket, moved and showed well.

3 Driftway Carbon Copy (G Spagnolo)

Lovely head and expression, good all round angles, deep solid body, firm top line held on the move, in good coat with a well covered tail, moved well.

CLASS 10 : AUSTRALIAN BRED DOG (10 entries – 2 absent)

Sup Ch Driftway Aussie Rulz (G Williams & G Spagnolo) Best Dog, Best in Show, Best Australian Bred.

This dog caught my eye as he came into the ring, very active and very showy. A solid well bodied dog with a clean outline. Nicely proportioned head with a really pleasing expression, using his ears to advantage. Beautifully angulated front, fullness of fore chest, his top line flowed from the top of his head to the tip of his tail. A powerful well angulated rear that drove him around the ring so effortlessly with good extension.

2 Ch Graebar Study In Light (S & R Malseed)

Beautifully balanced dog in solid condition, pleasing head proportions, with a good length of muzzle and correct bite, excellent reach of neck, firm top line, well developed rear, standing fore square at all times, in good coat and moved well.

3 Labradell VIP (N Macrossan)

Solid well bodied dog in lovely condition, super head with good pigmentation, correct bite, well angulated front and rear, top line firm but tail set not as good as No. 1 and No. 2, moved well.

Class 11 : OPEN DOG (8 entries – 2 absent)

1 Sup Ch Bonnsway Perfect Time (Ms D Travers) Best Open

Yellow dog in super condition, really loved his head and expression, great reach of neck and well angulated front, firm top line and correct tail set, strong powerful rear, good reach and extension on the move.

2 Ch Gunnislake Smart In Black (Mrs E Gent)

Black dog in tip top condition, delightful head and expression, well balanced throughout, firm top line, good bone and feet, moved well.

3 Ch & NZ Ch Roughfield Grand Design (Imp NZ) (Kerwick/Dunstan)

Yellow dog beautifully presented, with good all round angles, clean outline, top line flowing through to his tail, masculine head and expression, moved and showed well.

CLASS 1A: BABY PUPPY BITCH (14 entries – 3 absent) A beautiful class of babies full of promise.

1 Driftway Dashing About (Spanswick/Spagnolo)

A really lovely yellow puppy, beautiful head with lovely balanced proportions, super pigmentation. Good reach of neck on to well laid shoulders, firm top line and a strong rear, in excellent coat, good tail set and moved well.

2 Gunnislake Lili Marleen (Kerwick/Dunstan)

Sweet baby with a delightful head and expression, good pigmentation. Well angulated front and rear, firm top line held on the move, stood fore square, showed and moved well.

3 Kelindebar Black Pepper (AI) (Mrs L Adams)

Another lovely black puppy, attractive head and expression, correct bite, well balanced throughout, with a clean outline, good bone and feet, moved well.

CLASS 2A: MINOR PUPPY BITCH (6 entries – 1 absent)

1 Labzrina Once Upon A Dream (Mrs D Blaney) Best Minor Puppy

Love this puppy has great presence and style. Attractive well balanced head with a lovely eye and good pigmentation, clean through the neck, with good reach. Pleasing all round angles, deep bodied with good bone and tight feet, moved freely around the ring.

2 Driftway Moonlight Mist (G Spagnolo)

Very pretty yellow bitch, solid well bodied, with excellent bone and feet, in super coat and good otter tail, moved and showed well.

3 Eraky Night Sky (K & E Charnock)

Black bitch with pleasing head and expression, well angulated throughout, firm top line with correct tail set, moved well.

CLASS 3A: PUPPY BITCH (6 entries – 1 absent)

1 Driftway Vanilla Kisses (Mrs K Jesse) Best Puppy in Show

Beautifully presented yellow bitch in superb condition, delightful head with good pigmentation, correct bite, good reach of neck on to a well angulated front, firm top line with deep body and good barrel rib, moved with drive and extension, in excellent coat.

2 Silverstream Frangipana (Mrs C Blackman)

A lovely puppy with a sweet expression, good pigmentation, correct dentition. Lovely outline, balanced throughout, in good coat of correct texture, moved well.

3 Catraz National Velvert (Catraz Kennels)

Very different type to No. 1 and No. 2 but very nice type overall. Pleasing head, good reach of neck, firm top line, not in the best of coat, moved ok.

CLASS 4 A: JUNIOR BITCH (8 entries – 1 absent) Super class!

1 Labradell Bliss (W Chang) Best Bitch & Best Junior, Best Opposite Sex.

This beautiful yellow bitch filled my eye and my heart. I just loved her presence and style, totally at one with her owner. Attractive well proportioned head, using her ears to advantage, good pigmentation and a beautiful kind eye — not too dark. Her front is so well made with a fullness of fore chest, deep barrel rib, short coupled, good turn of stifle and width of thigh. Flowing top line and tail set, in excellent coat and a super otter tail. Moved so well showing extension and drive.

2 Eraky Movie Star (K & E Charnock)

Another lovely yellow bitch, pretty head with balanced proportion, dark pigmentation. Well balanced throughout with good all round angles, in excellent coat, well covered tail, moved with drive.

3 Driftway Olympus (G Spagnolo)

Classy black bitch, shown in hard condition, deep bodied, well constructed with good angles to front and rear, ample bone, nice tight feet, moved well.

Class 5A: INTERMEDIATE BITCH (7 entries – 1 absent)

1 Ch Bonnsway A Matter Of Time (Ms D Travers) Best Intermediate

Beautiful bitch in tip top condition. Lovely head and expression with dark pigmentation, correct bite, super reach of neck on to a well angulated front, firm top line, good barrel rib, well developed rear, moved with drive around the ring.

2 Ch Catraz Tiramisu (Catraz Kennels)

Solid well bodied bitch in super condition. Pleasing head and expression correct pigmentation, well angulated front and rear, deep bodied, good barrel rib. In excellent coat, with a well clothed tail, moved and showed well.

3 Ch Kelindebar Aussie Dream (Mrs L Adams)

Very nice type of yellow, well balanced creating a good picture, excellent bone and substance, in good coat, pleasing head proportions, dark pigmentation, moved well.

Class 10A: AUSTRALIAN BRED BITCH (14 entries – 1 absent)

1 Gunnislake Corn Dolly (AI) (Mrs E Gent) Reserve Best Bitch

Beautiful yellow bitch with presence and style, delightful head with balanced proportions, super pigmentation. Good reach of neck on to well placed shoulders, firm top line, deep bodied with a good barrel rib. Well developed rear and excellent second thigh. Moved with power and drive with good extension. Correct double coat.

2 Ch Banderra Regal Harriet (Mrs S Richards)

A feminine yellow bitch in hard condition. Pleasing head proportions with dark pigmentation. Solid deep bodied with a well angulated front and rear, firm top line, in very good coat, good tail set, moved well.

3 Ch Aralyen For All Ovtime (Mrs A O'Connor)

Strongly built dark yellow bitch, in glorious coat, stood fore square and showed well. Balanced throughout, deep bodied. Nicely proportioned head with good pigmentation and a lovely expression, moved well.

CLASS 11A: OPEN BITCH (11 entries – 1 absent)

1 Ch Driftway Moonlight Serenade (G Spagnolo)

Beautifully balanced bitch with a delightful head with pleasing proportions, lovely kind intelligent expression, super reach of neck, well angulated front and rear, sweeping top line, deep body and good barrel rib, ample bone, with tight feet, moved with drive and extension enabling her to flow around the ring.

2 Ch Aralyen I Can hear Music (AI) (Mrs D Blaney)

Another lovely bitch in tip top condition. Super coat and well covered otter tail. Good all round angles, solid well bodied. Lovely head and expression with good pigmentation, moved and showed well.

3 Gr Ch Banderra Regal Matilda (Mrs S Richards)

Beautifully presented bitch in hard condition. Pleasing head with a soft expression, good reach of neck, flowing top line, correct tail set, moved well.
