ANNUAL TROPHIES: The club offers a wide range of prestigious annual trophies to members and their dogs.

RULES APPLICABLE TO ANNUAL TROPHIES

1. Members may claim points (for shows / trials held within the state of Queensland and may also include a maximum of two (2) interstate shows – only Labrador Specialities or Nationals) only after the date of ratification as members of the Club. Members who have resigned or become unfinancial during the period of the awards will not be eligible.
2. Only those results which have been published in “Otter Tales” or are in the hands of the results Co-ordinator by the closing date will be considered for awards.

Members are responsible for supplying in writing or by e-mail (phone calls will not be accepted) details of their show or trial success to the Co-ordinator and for supplying any corrections to or omissions from published results.

All title achievements are to be notified to the Editor.

Note: All results must be received within three (3) months of the date of the event.

Any results not meeting this deadline will not be published and therefore will not be eligible for inclusion in the Annual Trophy tally.

Results of Open Shows and Sweepstakes (Retrieving Sweepstakes accepted) will not be published (except for LRCQ Inc events) and as such are NOT to be included in Annual Trophy applications.

Results **MUST BE** submitted using the following format.

OR alternatively a copy of a qualifying certificate or challenge certificate will be accepted (provided all the information as set out below is listed thereon):

All applications for Annual Trophies are to be in writing, signed by the owners of the dog on the form prescribed and **must include copies of Challenge / BOB / Qualifying Obedience Certificates** (unless these have already been submitted for results – those received will be represented by an asterix next to the result in Otter Tales).
4. Closing date for applications for all Annual Trophies will be advised in the September / October issue of "Otter Tales". No further notice will be given.
5. Points can only be claimed for dogs which are the registered property of financial members of the club and which are domiciled in Queensland.
6. Points may be claimed for dogs which have died during the year provided that all other conditions of the award have been met.
7. Perpetual trophies will be held by the owner of the winning dog until November of the following year. Where applicable the recipient is responsible for engraving.
8. Any member who advertises the winning of an award before the closing date for claims will have that award withheld.
9. The Management Committee shall be responsible for adjudicating on all claims for Annual Trophies and for supplying results for publication in the January edition of "Otter Tales", their decision shall be final and no correspondence shall be entered into.

RULES FOR PERPETUAL TROPHIES

Please note the following rules in regards to the perpetual trophies as donated by and the Labrador Retriever Club of Qld Inc and our generous club members and other sponsors.

1. ALL trophies MUST be signed for in our trophy registry book when you take them into your possession. You also acknowledge that upon signing the trophy in to your care, that you are responsible for the trophies safe keeping for the year that you hold it.
2. Only current financial members of the club, and must be residents of Queensland, are eligible to take home with them the perpetual trophies as won at our Championship shows.

Best in Show "Am CH. ALLII O'KOOLAU'S FANTASY" Perpetual Trophy

Breeder of Best in Show AVOKAH Perpetual Trophy

Runner Up Best in Show MIKELLI Trophy

Please note that ALL applicable recipients are responsible for engraving the Perpetual Trophy with their details.

However, for those exhibitors that are not members of our club or from interstate, the LRCQ Inc will engrave the trophy on your behalf.

3. In regards to our End of Year PERPETUAL trophies, that ALL applicable recipients are responsible for engraving the Perpetual Trophy with their details.

PLEASE NOTE -

ANY perpetual trophies that are damaged or not returned to the club will incur a \$500 charge for the trophy to be replaced and all engraving redone.

ALL trophies will be purchased by the Trophy Steward on behalf of our sponsors. This will ensure consistency in the appearance of the trophies for that year and being able to have all trophies available at the trophy presentation of that year.

All of our generous sponsors will be advised of the cost of the either their donated trophy or the smaller take home trophy (if perpetual) after trophies have been selected (this will be kept reasonable). Then we would please ask that you reimburse the club for that expense prior to the AGM the following year.

TITLE TROPHIES

The Labrador Retriever Club of Queensland Inc. will recognise titles gained by financial members whose dogs are domiciled in Queensland. This recognition will be in the form of a trophy or memento to be decided by the Club's Management Committee throughout the year.

If you wish to receive a title trophy to be presented at the trophy presentation a copy of title certificate MUST be forwarded to the results Co-ordinator.

N.B. Please DO NOT send a copy of your pedigree certificate, it MUST be the TITLE CERTIFICATE.

A claim form is not necessary.

- Points:** To be calculated using BEST OF BREED points ONLY.
Best 10 show results to be claimed, which may include the LRCQ Inc Championship Show and the Brisbane Royal.
Copies of Best of Breed Certificates must accompany claim (unless copies already submitted and have been duly noted in Otter Tales as received).
- Trophy:** To be supplied annually by the LRCQ Inc.& kept by the winner for 12 months & a small replica to be retained by the winner.
N.B. This Trophy / Award is separate from Metropolitan and Country Show Dog / Bitch, therefore requires a separate application.

BURRUMTRAVIS PERPETUAL QLD OPPOSITE SEX SHOW LABRADOR OF THE YEAR

Best 10 show results to be claimed, which may include the LRCQ Inc Championship Show and the Brisbane Royal.
Copies of Best of Breed Certificates must accompany claim (unless copies already submitted and have been duly noted in Otter Tales as received).
- Trophy:** To be supplied annually by the LRCQ Inc.& kept by the winner for 12 months & a small replica to be retained by the winner.
N.B. This Trophy / Award is separate from Metropolitan and Country Show Dog / Bitch, therefore requires a separate application.

KYDEN PERPETUAL TROPHY – BEST STATE BRED IN QUEENSLAND SHOW LABRADOR OF THE YEAR

Trophy: To be supplied annually by the donor & kept by the winner for 12 months & a small replica to be retained by the winner.

DOUBLE EDGE TROPHY – COUNTRY SHOW DOG OF THE YEAR

Purpose: For the member's Labrador (dog) most successful in shows throughout the year. This award is open to all club members and relates to show successes outside the 150km radius of the Brisbane GPO (but only within the state of Queensland).

Points: To be awarded to the dog gaining most challenge/BOB points within the designated area. Best 10 shows to be claimed, **excluding** the LRCQ Inc Championship Show and Brisbane Royal.

Copies of Best of Breed Certificates must accompany claim (unless copies already submitted and have been duly noted in Otter Tales as received).

Trophy: To be supplied annually by the donor and retained by the winner.

BURRUMTRAVIS PERPETUAL TROPHY – COUNTRY SHOW BITCH OF THE YEAR

MAHELU PERPETUAL NORTH QUEENSLAND SHOW LABRADOR OF THE YEAR

Donor: Michelle and Brett Wheeler – Mahelu Labrador Retrievers

Purpose: To encourage the showing of Labradors by members residing and exhibiting between Far North Queensland (FNQ), North Queensland (NQ), and Central Queensland (CQ) (Gladstone being the most southern town) This includes part of Zone 2 and all of Zone 3. (This applies to those members that live and show their dogs in and above the area North of latitude 23 degrees (Includes Gladstone and towns West of latitude 23 degrees, it excludes towns south of Gladstone) – see attached map.)

Points: To be awarded to the dog or bitch gaining the most Challenge/BOB points within the designated area. Best 10 show results to be claimed (including Best in Show and Best in Group awards).

Shows will include: Any shows from Gladstone Latitude 23 degrees to the North and West, it excludes any towns south of Gladstone. For example, the following towns and surrounding areas will include Gladstone, Rockhampton, Sarina, Mackay, Pioneer Valley, Proserpine, Bowen, Townsville, Charters Towers, Ingham, Tully, Innisfail, Cairns, Mareeba, Atherton, Cloncurry. **Excluding** the LRCQ Inc. Championship Show, Brisbane Royal, and the Labrador Retriever National when it is held in Queensland.

Copies of Best of Breed Certificates must accompany claim (unless copies already submitted and have been duly noted in Otter Tales as received).

Trophy: To be supplied annually by the donor and kept by the winner for 12 months and a small replica to be retained by the winner.

NB – This award reflects the involvement in the Labrador Retriever breed by the sponsors from Gladstone to Far North Queensland since 1994. We would like to acknowledge all the wonderful dogs we have had the pleasure to own and show.



SLINGUN PERPETUAL TROPHY

- Donor:** Mr & Mrs Slingo – Slingun Labrador Retrievers.
- Purpose:** To encourage up and coming young Labrador Retrievers which do not have a Championship Title.
- Conditions:** Points may be counted up to and including the Show in which qualification for a title is completed. Show Dog/Bitch of the year are not eligible. A separate application is required for this award and no points are allowed which have been won after the dog has reached 18 months of age. Claims to be made for 10 best Championship Shows within Queensland and may include the Brisbane Royal and LRCQ Inc Championship Show (i.e. 8 shows + Royal + LRCQ Inc.)

Copies of Challenge/BOB certificates must accompany the claim.

WINTOPPI BRIDESMAID'S TROPHY

Purpose: To encourage those who "just miss out" to continue showing.

Points: Reserve Challenges only (within the state of Queensland) to be taken into consideration up to the show at which show title is achieved. Dogs having a Championship Title from overseas are not eligible.

No application required – results will be taken from results as published in Otter Tales.

Trophy: To be supplied annually by the donor and retained by the winner.

LABRADDELL PERPETUAL TROPHY – BEST CHOCOLATE SHOW LABRADOR OF THE YEAR

Donor: Mr Wilhelm Chang - Labraddell Labradors.

Purpose: For the most successful Chocolate Labrador in conformation shows throughout the year.

Points: To be awarded to the best chocolate dog or bitch gaining the most challenge/BOB points. Claims to be made for 10 best Championship Shows within Queensland and may include the Brisbane Royal, LRCQ Inc Championship Show and National (when held in Queensland).

Copies of Challenge / Best of Breed Certificates must accompany claim (unless copies already submitted and have been duly noted in Otter Tales as received).

Trophy: To be supplied annually by the donor & kept by the winner for 12 months & a small replica to be retained by the winner.

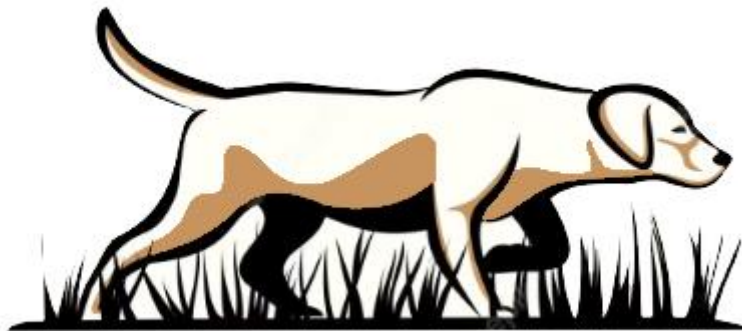
