The worldwide web is a very valuable tool enabling breed enthusiasts to keep in close and regular contact. Unfortunately there are those who would see to use “the web” and various social networking sites like Facebook as a conduit to quite blatantly promote their stock to Judges well ahead of the sanctioned event. These same disreputable exhibitors could also go to great lengths to discredit the exhibits of their fellow competitors and their dogs.

This type of activity is not acceptable and will not be tolerated by the LRCQ Inc. If you should receive any form of communication (either electronically or in hard copy) please support the strong stance taken by the LRCQ Inc and report this activity immediately.

Even if you are unsure about the intent of a communication you have received we would ask that you alert our Club Secretary.

Protecting your reputation as a Specialist Judge and the reputation of our Club is critically important to us – we are determined to stamp out this type of underhanded activity before it ever gets a foothold.
